<p>Live sessions</p>	<p>There is a live phonics session today at 10:20am and a live story time at 2:40pm. The links were sent for these via ParentMail. We look forward to seeing you all there.</p>
<p>Reading (15 minutes)</p> <p>Live story (15 minutes)</p>	<p>Continue to work on reading books on Bug Club: https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/.</p> <p>Remember it is important to reread books to develop fluency and expression. Encourage your child to discuss the texts they read and answer the comprehension questions by clicking on the bug on selected pages. Please note that books are not registered as completed until your child has answered the comprehension questions. Class teachers only see completed books, not opened books and so unless questions are answered and books completed we are unable to tell if you have read your allocation.</p>
<p>Phonics (20 minutes)</p>	<p>Phonics will be taught live at 10:20am via the link you received through parentmail. It will follow the plan highlighted below.</p> <p>You will need a pencil and a piece of paper for today's Phonics lesson.</p> <p>Recap: Miss Brown will recap on some previously taught graphemes and tricky words using flashcards.</p> <p>Teach: Today we will be looking at adding the 'er' ending with no change needed for the root word in words like buzzer and hunter. Mrs Trotter has left us a note today about the Big Bad Wolf.</p> <p>Practice: We will be playing Kim's Game today with the words quicker, buzzer, boxer, stronger.</p> <p>Apply: Together we will read the sentence: 'The wolf is quicker and stronger than you.'</p>
<p>Handwriting/ Spelling (15 minutes)</p>	<p>Please take a look at today's video where Mrs Mercer will show you how to complete the joins 'lp' and 'mp' and the patterns.</p> <p>https://youtu.be/87XqFcpR4KE</p>
<p>English (25 minutes)</p>	<p>LO: to edit a story.</p> <p>Starter: Read through your whole story to someone in your house, it might even be your favourite toy.</p> <p>Main Activity:</p> <p>Today we would like you to make some changes to your story based on the feedback that you were given on Seesaw by Miss Brown and Mrs Mercer. You might want to go back and add some more detail into your sentences, or add in some missing full stops and capital letters. If you have a different colour pencil or a pen, you might want to make your changes using that, so you can see where you have made your changes.</p> <p>Maybe you could choose one particular part and edit that part. Make your changes in a different colour.</p>

<p>Maths (30 minutes)</p>	<p>LO: to understand weight and mass. For today's starter, take a look at Mrs Mercer's video where she will run through the starter and the learning for today.</p> <p>Main Activity: Today we are introducing you to weight and mass. We will be discussing key vocabulary such as heavier, lighter, heavier than and lighter than. We would like you to take a look at the worksheet and label which object is heavier or lighter using the letter (H) or (L). Can you explain why each object is heavier or lighter than the other? <p>Topic (20 minutes)</p>	<p>Science LO: To identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials for particular uses. To gather and record data to help in answering questions. Before we build our house for Mrs Trotter, we need to do some tests on different materials to see whether they would be waterproof enough for her roof. We will be testing 5 different materials to see whether they 'repel' water or 'absorb' it.
