

Home Learning Tasks for Y6

This home learning letter provides your child with learning activities from various areas of the curriculum to complete at home. Each area of learning will have a link which you can use to access the work. Please ensure the maths and English tasks are completed in the morning and the foundation activities completed in the afternoon, as it would be in school.

One Maths and English task should be completed every day and 30 min of PE. One foundation activity must be completed each day (RE, Topic, Computing). Please ensure your child completes a minimum of 2-3 GPS tasks a week and reads a/some of their book every day.

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English (x 60 minutes each day)	 This half term, we will be reading the historical poem 'The Highwayman' and turning it into a piece of narrative writing. You will identify and analyse key characters and scenes in the plot, explore effective vocabulary and write a narrative yourself. 	video in full prior to completing the task. Start at lesson 1 and continue to work your way through the lessons each day, missing out any spelling sessions.
