Dear Parent/carers,

We are delighted to be able to start fitness and fun clubs after school for Years 1 - 6.

These clubs will offer a range of activities to help improve physical fitness and mental wellbeing and will include fun games and activities which will help improve children's fitness levels. Clubs will run on the following days.

Day	Year group
Monday	Year 2 (this half term) and Year 1 (next half term)
Tuesday	Year 5
Wednesday	Year 6
Thursday	Year 3
Friday	Year 4

Clubs will end at 4:15pm and children will be dismissed from their year group door rather than from the main entrance.

We have aligned the club with the day that your child has their PE lesson so they will already be in their PE kit ready to take part in the club and will not need to change before they go home.

If you would like your child to be considered for a place in the club, please complete the reply slip below by Wednesday 23rd September. Spaces will be limited but if a year group is oversubscribed, we may run one group this half term and one from October half term onwards. Please note that if your child has a place in a Junior School squad, it is unlikely they will get a place in this club. Clubs will start on Monday 28th September.

The cost of attending gala, squads or clubs is £15 for the term. This is not a voluntary contribution and is a requirement if students wish to take part in clubs or squads. Please make payment through ParentPay.

We would ask that this payment is made by Wednesday 23rd September to allow enough time for the applications to be processed. Students who have not had the payment made



will not be allocated a club. In the unlikely event of your child not being selected for a squad or allocated a club that they wish to attend, your payment will be refunded.

Katherine Semar Schools are committed to ensuring that all students are able to access clubs. If your child is supported by the Pupil Premium Grant (they are currently receiving free school dinners or have received free school dinners within the last 6 years, not including universal free school meals in the Infant School), then we will cover the cost of their club payment. If you are eligible for support through the Pupil Premium Grant, but feel that you are able to make the payment, then please make it through ParentPay as normal. If you are not entitled to Pupil Premium Grant support, but feel this charge would cause you financial difficulties, please contact the school office to discuss this.
