




Artist: David Hockney (1937)

Key Vocabulary			
	media	The art technique or material that you use to express your art.	
	mixed media	This refers to visual art that combines a variety of media in a single artwork. For example, if you draw with ink then paint over it with watercolours.	
Paint	tools	An implement used to carry out a particular task. In paint, the tools available are pen (to draw), fill, type, eraser, colour picker and magnifier.	
	brushes	Used to apply a liquid or powder to a surface. In this case, you can choose the different styles of brush in order to achieve different textures or strokes.	
	line width	How wide the line is. This is used when using the pen tool to freehand draw.	
	colour	The general term we use to describe every hue, tint, tone or shade we see. White, black and grey are often referred to as a colour. These can be selected from the options given or edited to create tints, tones and shades.	
	fill	To cause a space to become full. If a shape is drawn in Paint, this tool will fill it with a solid colour.	
	eraser	To rub out or remove.
