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| This week in Year One... | <p>The children have had another brilliant week in Year 1! The children have completed their Art week this week and have been looking at the artist Henri Matisse. The children have designed and made their own collage based on Matisse's Garden.</p> |
| Partnered Reading | <p>In Partnered Reading this week the children have been looking at three different books. We have allocated each book to the children on Bug Club so that the children can show you how much they have progressed in their reading throughout the week. | Reminder | <p>Please continue to read with your child daily. At school we have started a new initiative for children who read at home daily. The children's names will be placed into a hat and chosen at random every week. | Maths | <p>In Maths this week the children have been working on their addition and subtraction skills. They have been using counters, tens frames and also number lines to add two numbers together up to 20, as well as subtracting numbers within 20 as well.</p> |
| English | <p>We have been continuing our work of <i>The Three Little Pigs</i> this week. The children have been deciding whether the characters from the book are less intelligent or more intelligent based on what they did in the book.</p> <p>E.g. the 1st pig is the least intelligent as his house was build out of straw.</p> |

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| <p>Phonics</p> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This week in Phonics the children have been learning how to add the suffix 'ing to words such as 'jumping, hunting, singing'. - The children have also been learning c, k, and ck in words such as 'market, black, and hammock'. - Ch and qu making the 'c' sound. - We have also been learning to spell the words 'once, little, friend and could as well as reading the word 'two'. |
