Year One – Week Commencing 21st February 2022

<p>This week in Year One...</p>	<p>The children have had a fantastic start to this half-term. It was lovely to go swimming again on Wednesday and it was lovely to see how much confidence the children have in the water!</p>
<p>Partnered Reading</p>	<p>In Partnered Reading this week the children have been looking at three different books. We have allocated each book to the children on Bug Club so that the children can show you how much they have progressed in their reading throughout the week. Ask your child which book they have read this week.</p> <p>The Third Whirligig Sunflowers Let's Rock</p>
<p>Reminder</p>	<p>Please remember that this half-term it will be PE on a Tuesday and Wednesday. The children will have swimming on a Wednesday and will need to come to school wearing their costumes/trunks underneath. Please bring in a large bag a cap, towel and clean underwear and goggles if you have any. The children need to be able to fit all of their uniform in their bag before getting in the pool so please ensure the bag is a sufficient size.</p> <p>Please can all children attending a club please come dressed in their PE kits all day for school.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>In Maths this week the children have been recapping their inequality symbols of more than, less than and equal to. The children have been using them to compare objects as well as numbers. Following this we have also been working on our multiplication skills. The children have been working on counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s. We have been using lots of different resources to aid in our counting.</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>This week we have been looking at nonsense poems. We have sung lots of nursery rhymes and also learnt the poem 'On The Ning Nang Nong' and 'Quack went the Billy Goat'. The children have been performing these poems as well as creating their own version of the poem 'On The Ning Nang Nong'.</p>

<p>Phonics</p>	<p>This week in Phonics the children have been learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Words containing the sound 'gn' such as 'gnat', 'gnaw' and 'design'. - Words containing the sound 'wr' such as 'wrinkle', 'wreath' and 'write'. - Words containing the 'tch' sound such as 'patch', 'catch' and 'kitchen'. - Spelling the words <i>where</i> and <i>were</i>. - Spelling the words <i>six, seven, eight, nine and ten</i>.
<p>This week's spellings:</p>	<p>This week's spellings are: Six, seven, eight, nine, ten.</p>

To support your child's learning at home this week you could...

Spelling – Rainbow Spelling – fill up the Rainbow with all of your spelling words this week. One word can go in each section of the rainbow. All you need is some coloured pencils/pens.



Geography – What human and physical features can you see from outside your bedroom window? Remember that Human features are things that have been built/made by people such as houses, parks, roads, path etc. and physical features are things that are not made or built and were already here such as grass, trees etc.
