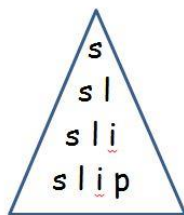
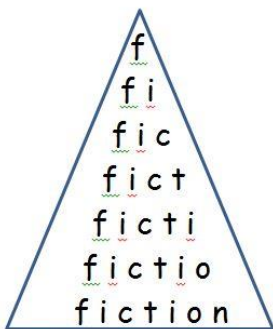
Year One – Week Commencing 28th February 2022

This week in Year One...	<p>The children have had another fantastic week this week with World Book Day! The children had so much to enjoy this year with it being their 25th Anniversary celebration. The children had the opportunity to read with some buddies in another year group, as well as listen to a storyteller read them a book. The children's costumes were all so imaginative and the children LOVED figuring out who the masked readers were this year!</p>
Partnered Reading	<p>In Partnered Reading this week the children have been looking at three different books. We have allocated each book to the children on Bug Club so that the children can show you how much they have progressed in their reading throughout the week. Ask your child which book they have read this week.</p> <p>The Third Whirligig Sunflowers Let's Rock</p>
Reminder	<p>Please remember that this half-term it will be PE on a Tuesday and Wednesday.</p> <p>Please can all children attending a club please come dressed in their PE kits all day for school.</p>
Maths	<p>In Maths the children have been continuing their work of counting in groups. The children have been counting in groups of 5, then looking at images to find out how many groups of 5 they have. The children have also consolidated their knowledge of counting and have been working very hard on their number bonds within 10 and 20.</p>
English	<p>This week the children have been introduced to the world of portal stories. The children have started to look at the book 'The Tunnel', coming up with some predictions of what might be at the end of the tunnel. The children have also been looking at setting descriptions and what they need to include in this. We need to ensure that we use all of our 5 senses when doing this to create an image in the readers head.</p>

<p>Phonics</p>	<p>This week in Phonics the children have been learning:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learning the alternative pronunciation of 'e' in words such as 'bread' and 'lead'. - Learning the sounds 'cial' and 'ch' in the words 'chef' and 'special'. - Learning the sounds 'sion' and 'tion' in words such as 'mission' and 'fiction'. - Recapping the spelling of tricky words including asked, looked and called.
<p>This week's spellings:</p>	<p>This week's spellings are: tadpole, hatch, chicken, animal, wild. You can also find the spellings in your child's reading diary each week too.</p>
