

Weekly Learning Letter


Year One – Week Commencing 2nd October


	This week Red Squirrels enjoyed their second session at forest school, they enjoyed building dens, making clay creatures and sliding down the mud slide.
This week in Year One	Skylarks completed their computing unit on Online Safety, thinking about copyright and ownership of images. They created their own digital portraits using the SketchesSchool app and uploaded them onto Seesaw.
	We also completed our art unit on scultpure. We looked at the artist Andy
	Goldsworthy and used inspiration from his work to create our own natural sculptures.
Reminder	Remember we will have PE every Monday so you will need to come into school in your kit. Your child will have forest school three times this term. Please can they come to school in their uniform with clothes they can get muddy and wellies in a bag.
Maths	In Maths this week we have been using a part whole model and partitioning numbers into two parts. We have been using the stem sentence: A part is A part is The whole is to explain how we have partitioned amounts. We have also been writing a number sentence to match our part whole models focusing on addition.
English	In English we read the story Charlie's Superhero Underpants. This is a quest story. We started the week by writing our own quest stories and created a group text map to accompany the model text. We worked on orally re-telling the story using pictures and props and though about our favourite parts of the story.
Phonics	This week in Phonics we have been recapping our phase 3 graphemes and starting to look at some phase 5 graphemes: ay, a_e, and other ai alternatives (neigh, great, steak, vein, grey, eight, survey)
This week's spellings:	You will find this week's spellings have been stuck in your child's reading diary. Please help your child learn their spellings ready for their first Big Spell at the end of this term.


To support your child's learning at home this week you could...
