This week in Year Two	We have started our new topic The Lighthouse Keeper's Daughter this week. Using evidence, we were history detectives and tried to work out what had happened in the story of Grace Darling. We then learnt about Grace Darling as a significant individual in history and why she is famous.

English	This week we have been introduced to our new story Gracie the Lighthouse Cat. We have acted out the story and explored how the characters are feeling throughout the story. We then sequenced to story to help us understand how the story has been structured. We then went onto understanding the characters further by writing a thank you letter as Gracie's kitten. We used our writing checklist to write a character description and used adverbs within this description.
Maths	This week we have learnt how to subtract two 2-digit numbers with and without exchanging. We then went onto finding and making number bonds to 20, leading up to finding and making number bonds to 100. We have also added three 1-digit numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations and learnt mental strategies for doing this.
Phonics & Spelling	This week we have revisited the spelling of some tricky words which we have learnt. We then went onto reading, spelling and applying our new spellings which are all topic related words.
