### WHAT HAVE WE BEEN LEARNING?

KS1

This term our KS1 children have been enjoying a full and varied programme of sport and PE. Our Early Years have been working with Mrs Boyd to improve their strength using their bodies to make different shapes in dance and yoga. And they have been developing their gross motors skills and ball control learning different ball games with Mr Gilkes. 
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### INFANT TEDDY BEAR RUN, SANTA DASH & MULTISKILLS AT LBLC
