Year One – Week Commencing 29.1.24

This week in Year One...	<p>This week we have continued with our art learning and designed our own collage inspired by Henri Matisse. In science, we have enjoyed sorting and grouping materials based on their properties.</p> <p>Skylarks have started their RE unit on Judaism and Red Squirrels have explored the Bee-bots in computing.</p>
Reminder	<p>Children have their PE days on a Monday and Wednesday. Children will need to come to school in their PE kits.</p> <p>Friday – Every Friday we have reading morning where parents can stay and listen to their child read in class for 10 minutes. If you are unable to attend your child will pair up with a friend.</p> <p>Lucky Listener – Please remember to hear your child read their book on Bug Club and tick the lucky listener sticker to show that they have read their book to you.</p>
English	<p>In English, we have been writing our own version of the three little pigs. The children changed the characters in the story and picked a new 'baddie'. The children created their own story mountain to plan their ideas and orally rehearsed their stories. The children then wrote up their stories with a focus on capital letter, full stops, adjectives and using the five part story plan.</p>
Maths	<p>In maths, we have been completing fact families for numbers within 20. E.g $12 + 4 = 16$, $4 + 12 = 16$, $16 - 12 = 4$ and $16 - 4 = 12$. We have also been comparing numbers within 20 and working out missing number problems.</p>
Phonics	<p>In phonics this week we spelt words ending in nk and ve. We have also consolidated our learning by spelling words by adding the suffix 'ing' to root words. E.g jumping, cooking, standing, sweeping.</p> <p>We have learnt to read: please, school</p> <p>We have learnt to spell: once, our, two</p>
This week's spellings:	<p>This week's spellings have been stuck into your child's reading diary. Please help your child to learn these words at home each week so they are ready for the Big Spell at the end of the half term.</p>
