English	This week we have begun to innovate our story e.g. The Gigantic Carrot / The Gigantic Parsnip.  The children have innovated their story mountains, told their story to an adult for scribing and then performed their innovations to the class.

	This week we have also learnt to read two new tricky words: live qive

- Practice reading phase 3 tricky words. You may wish to go on a tricky word hunt in your house. ( a set of tricky words is attached )
