Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on their PE days.

- Year 1 children should also wear their PE kit to school with their swimming costume on underneath on swimming days.
- Year 4/5 children should wear their school uniform on Swimming days and bring their swimwear to change into at the pool.
- Early Years should wear their Forest School clothes into school on their Forest School day (with wellies in a plastic bag).















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Term time holidays

Children of compulsory school age who are registered at a school must, by law, attend that school regularly.

- Regular attendance is the best way of ensuring that a child makes the most of the educational opportunities available to him or her.
- When a child is absent from school, he or she misses not only the teaching provided but is also less prepared for the lessons after his or her return.
- There are only 190 statutory school days in one year and 175 days (weekends and school holidays) available to use for holidays or leave. Therefore, every school day counts!

Your rights and responsibilities

- If your child is registered at a school you must ensure that they attend regularly.
- The regulations make it clear that parents do not have any right or entitlement to take a child out of school for the purposes of a term time holiday.
- If parents take their child on holiday or leave in term time, this will be counted as an unauthorised absence. This will mean you receive a penalty notice fine issued or prosecution in the Magistrates court.

Parent School dinners

Just a reminder that parents/grandparents are welcome to join children for lunches. The cost of a parent meal is £5.00. To book please email the office on admin-inf@katherinesemar.net with the date you wish to attend (3 day's notice is required) and the colour meal (green or yellow) you would like. We will then confirm whether we have availability on this date and how you can make payment. If you have booked to come for lunch in the infants, please go to the main office at 11.55am, for the Juniors please go to the main office at 12.05. Please note parents will eat lunch with their child but are not permitted to go out into the playground afterwards – this is for safeguarding reasons. Parents are also not permitted to use their mobile phones whilst in the dinner hall.
