

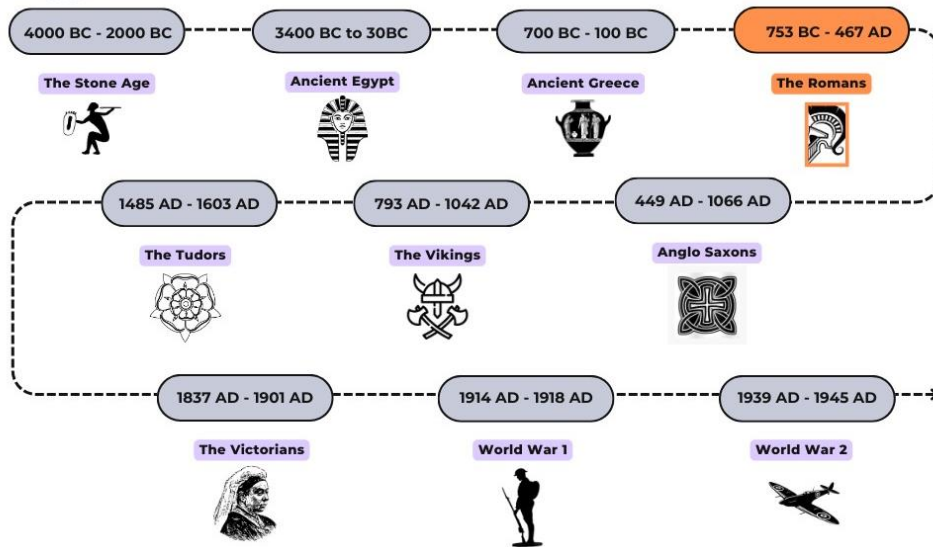

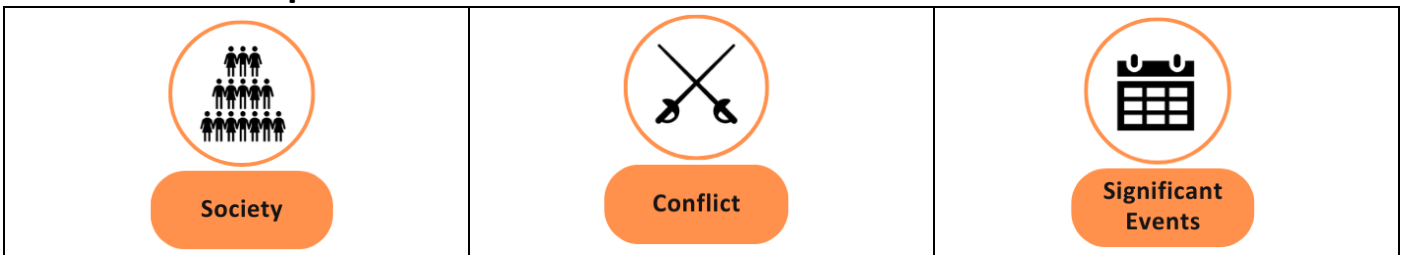

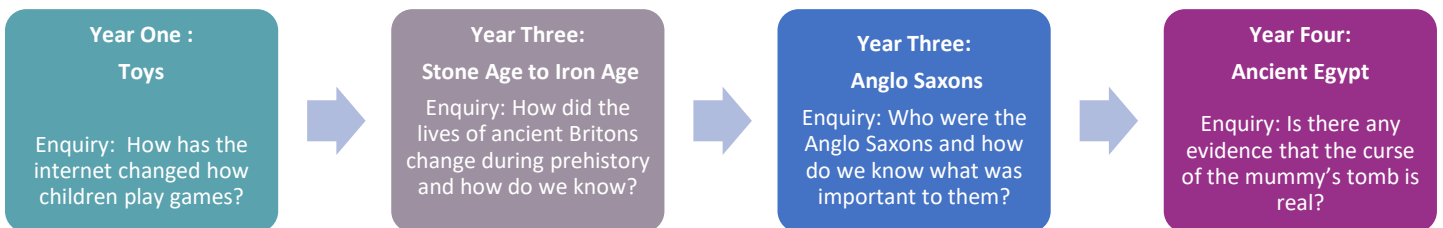

### Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
<b>Army</b>	An organised group of fighters.
<b>Citizen</b>	Someone who has rights in a particular place.
<b>Conquer</b>	To defeat someone or something usually with force, e.g. with an army.
<b>Government</b>	The system of laws, people and officials that define and control the country you live in.
<b>Invasion</b>	The movement of an army into a region as part of a war or conflict.
<b>Leader</b>	The person in charge, who convinces others to follow.
<b>Military</b>	Describes anything related to armed forces such as the army or navy.
<b>Rebel</b>	To fight against authority (those in power).
<b>Repress</b>	To control or limit freedoms.
<b>Retreat</b>	To withdraw soldiers away from danger.
<b>Society</b>	People living together in a community, sharing culture.
<b>Soldier</b>	Someone who is part of an army.
<b>Warrior</b>	Someone experienced in warfare.
