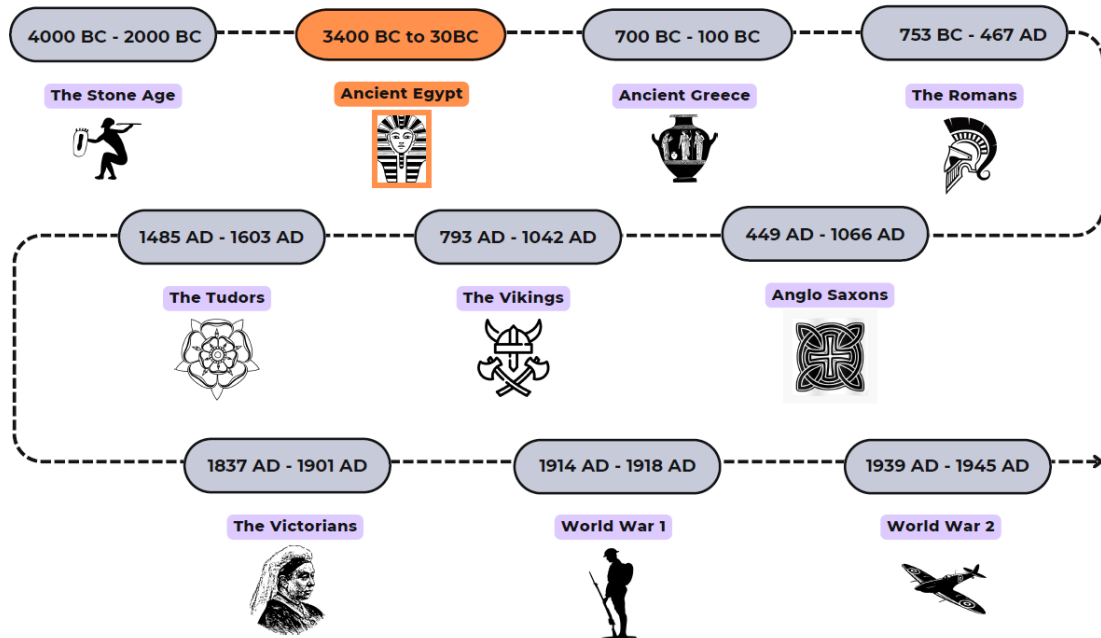

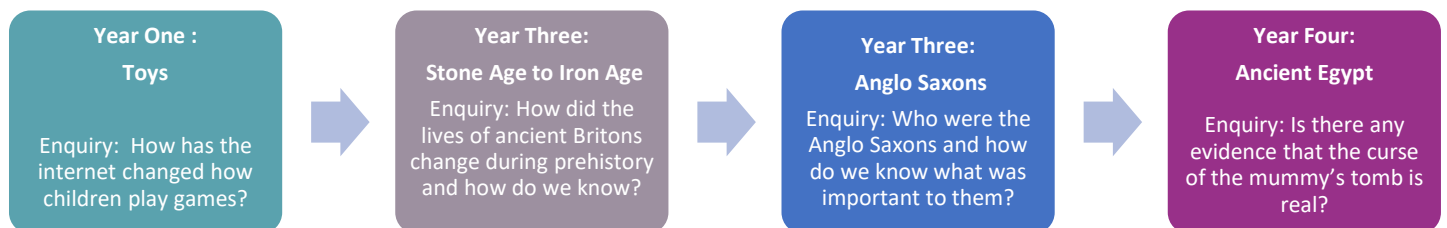

Word	Definition
Ancient	Belonging to times long past especially of the historical period before the fall of the Roman Empire.
Burial	A burial is the act of placing a dead person in a grave.
After life	Afterlife is a noun describing the state of being after one's death.
Gods	A god is a supreme being or deity.
Archaeologist	An archaeologist is a scientist who studies human history by digging up human remains and artifacts.
Artefacts	An artifact is a man-made object that has some kind of cultural significance.
Slave	A person who is owned by someone.
Ruler	a person who rules or commands.
Tomb	A place for the burial of a dead person.
Irrigation	The act of supplying dry land with water.
