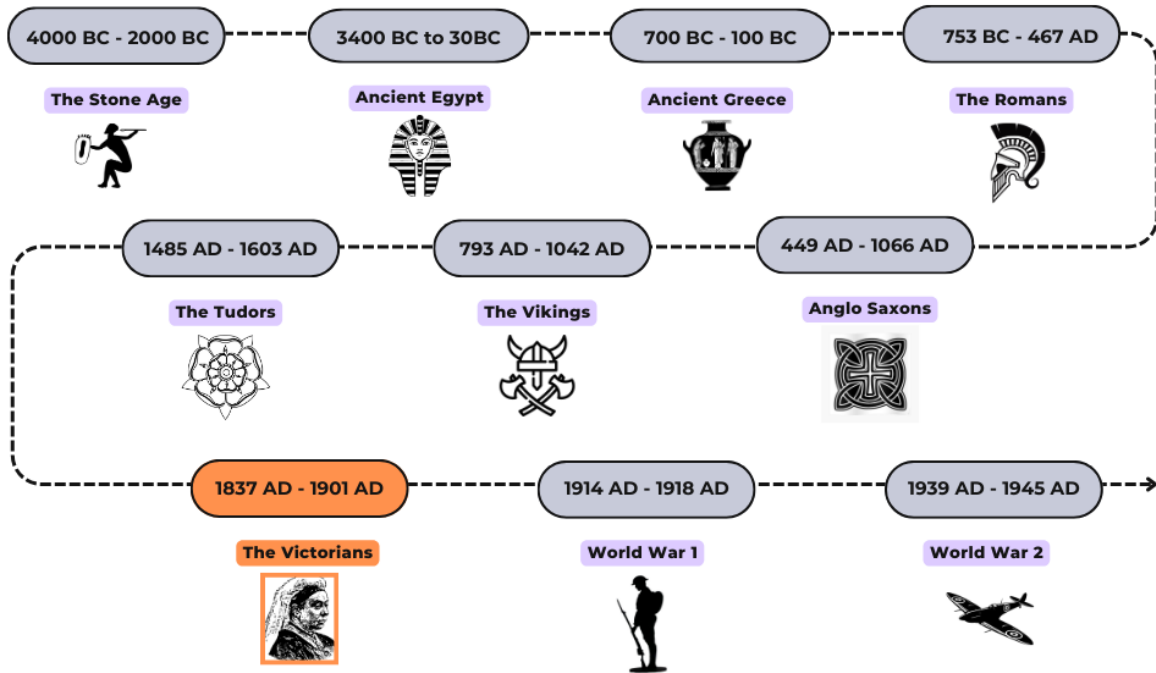

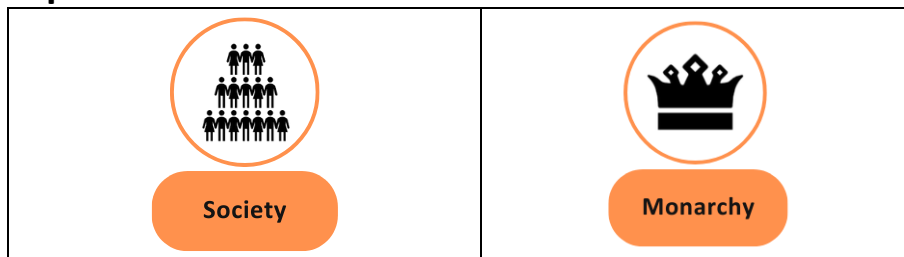

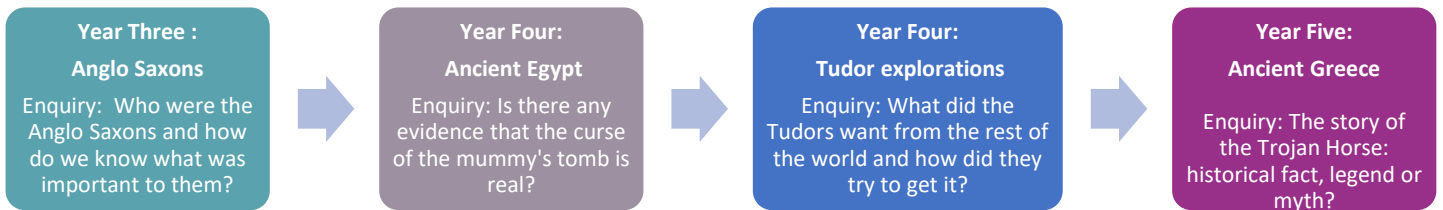

Word	Definition
Act	A law agreed by Parliament.
Poverty	The state of having little or no money and few or no material possessions.
Government	The organization that is the governing authority of a political unit.
Petition	A formal request that something be submitted to authority.
Lobbying	To attempt to influence lawmakers on an issue.
Industrialisation	The development of an industry on an extensive scale.
Innovation	The act of starting something for the first time.
Invention	The act of making something new.
Progress	The act of moving forward in a positive direction.
Inequality	Lack of balance and similarity.
Monarchy	A form of government that has a single person known as a monarch as its head.
