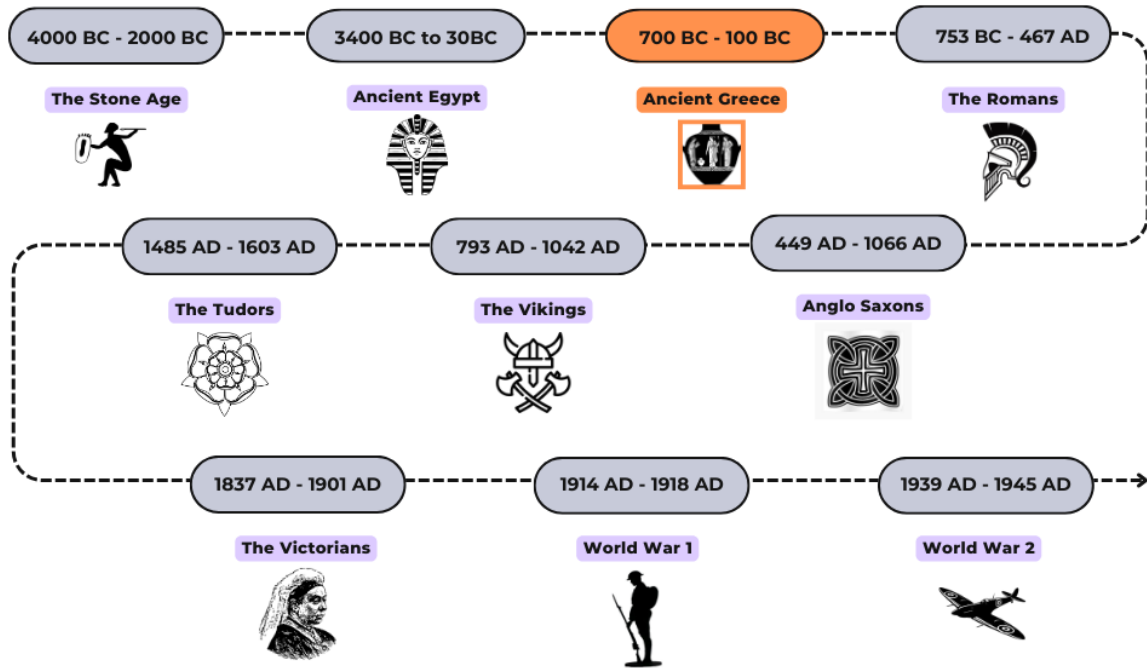

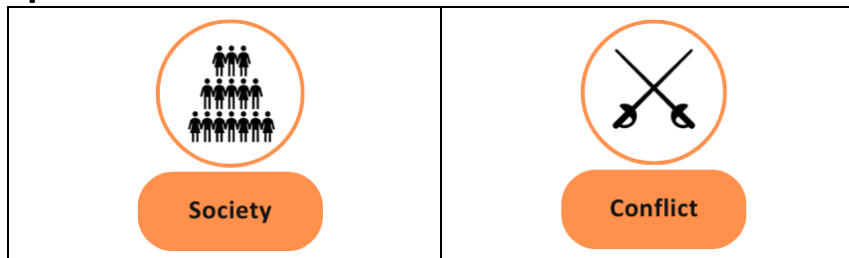

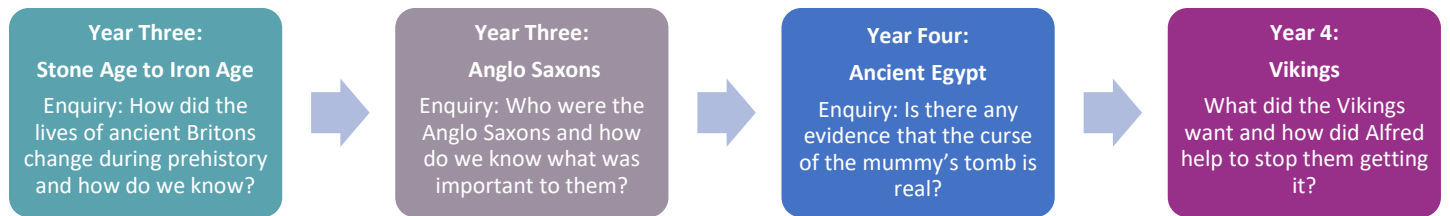

### Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
<b>Primary source</b>	An original document or artefact from a time period or a person who has firsthand knowledge about events.
<b>Secondary source</b>	An article or book that discusses information that was first presented somewhere else.
<b>Archaeologist</b>	A person who studies prehistoric civilisations.
<b>Democracy</b>	Government based on participation of the people, either directly or by chosen representatives.
<b>Myth</b>	A story that's told again and again and serves to explain why something is the way it is.
<b>Legend</b>	A story about mythical beings that gets passed down from one generation to the next.
<b>Tactics</b>	Carefully planned actions for attaining a certain goal.
<b>Hierarchy</b>	A system that organizes or ranks things, often according to power or importance.
