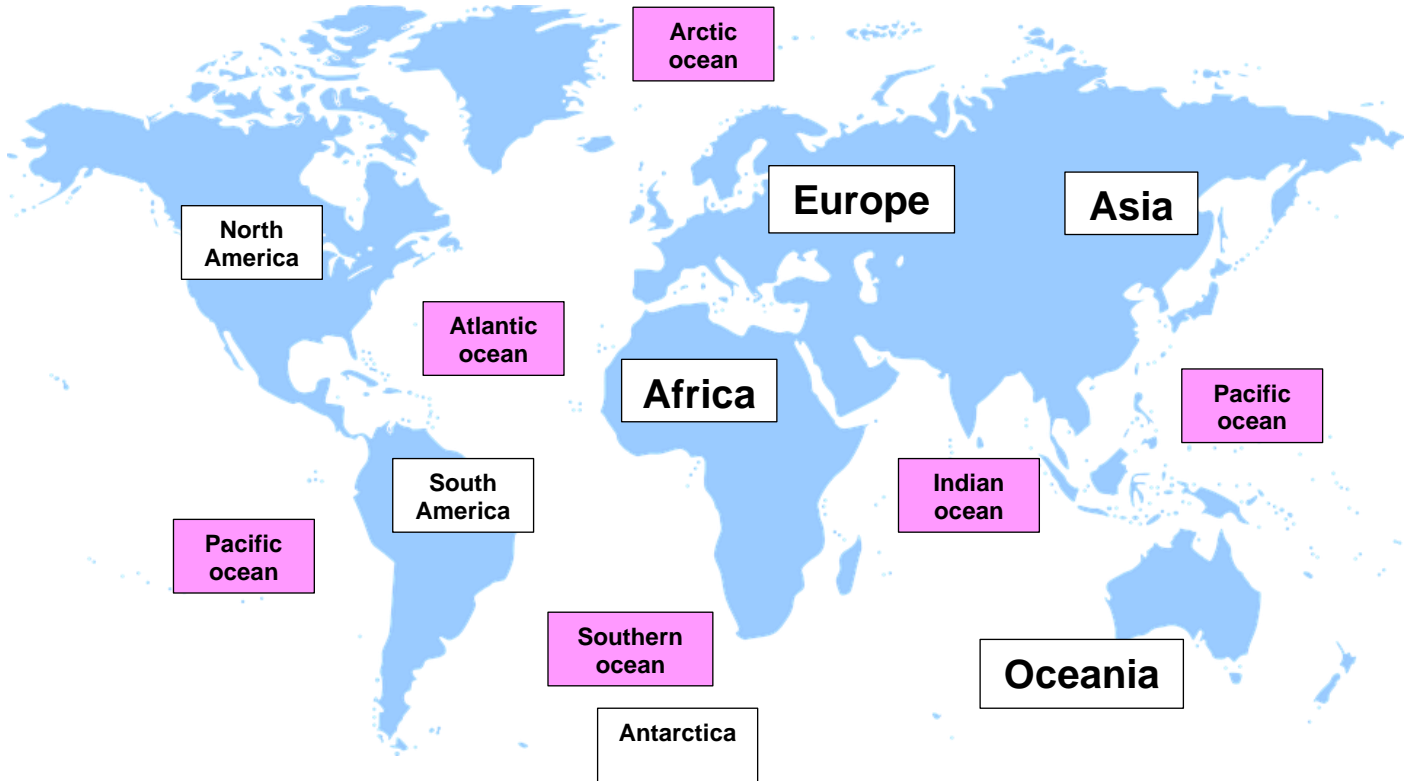


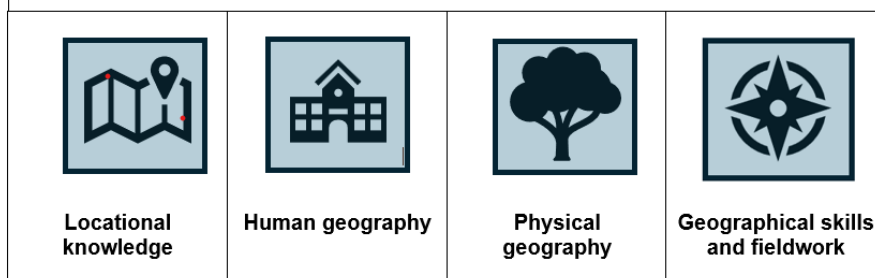

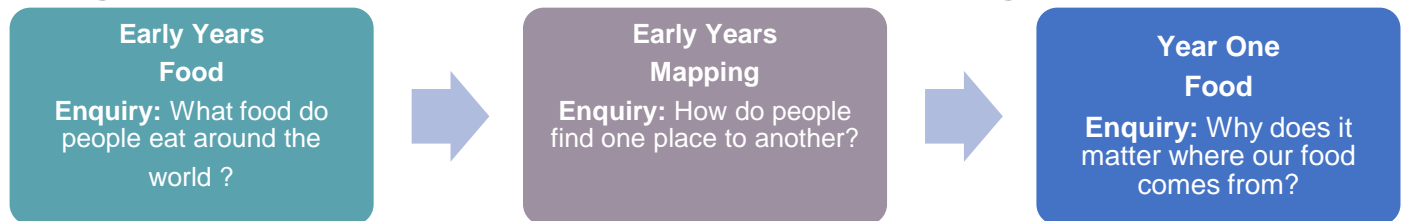

## Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
<b>Shoreline</b>	the place where a large body of water, like an ocean, lake, or river, meets the land.
<b>Coastal erosion</b>	the process of the coastline being worn away by destructive waves.
<b>Sea wall</b>	a large barrier built along the shoreline to protect against flooding and lessen the effects of coastal erosion.
<b>Rock armour</b>	large boulders used to reduce the waves reaching the shoreline
<b>Breakwater</b>	a protective structure of stone or concrete; extends from shore into the water to prevent a beach from washing away
<b>Groynes</b>	a protective structure of stone or concrete; extends from shore into the water to prevent a beach from washing away
