LO: To identify coins.

With your grown ups' permission, can you go on a hunt for real money (1p, 2p, 5p, 10p). **If you do not have real money at home, you can draw your own coins or you can print out the attached money sheet.** Look carefully at the coins how do you know it is 1 penny? How do you know it is a 2 pence? How do you know it is 10 pence? How are the coins different? How are the coins the same?

Miss Munro has three 1 penny coins



Mrs Dolby has a 5 pence coin



Who has less? Who has more? How do you know?

This time, Miss Munro has five 1 penny coins



Mrs Dolby still has a 5 pence coin?



Who has less? Who has more? How do you know?

**Activity: A game to play with a grown up or an older sibling, each take coin(s) (1p, 2p, 5p, 10p). Don't let your partner see yet... look at what you have picked up- how much do you have? Can you predict (say) if you may have more or less or the same (equal) as your partner (without peeking at what they have in their hands).**

**Make sure you place your coins down at the same time. Was your prediction right? Who had less? Who had more? Did you have the same amount? How do you know?**
