


Weekly Learning Letter

Year One – Week Commencing 30th September

<p>This week in Year One...</p>	<p>In Year 1 this week we have continued our science unit on seasonal change. We have been thinking about the weather in different seasons and made rain gauges to see how much it has been raining. Unsurprisingly they are already filling up quickly!!</p> <p>This week in Skylarks we have started our computing unit on Online Safety. We have been talking about ways in which we can communicate online and how important it is to be kind to others online. We have been using Book Creator to record voice notes about why it is important to be kind online and then sorted images into two groups, those that are safe to share and those that are not safe to share online.</p> <p>Red Squirrels have started their first geography lesson, looking at why it matters where our food comes from. We learnt the seven continents and what kinds of fruits and vegetables might grow there and how they end up in our country and our supermarkets.</p>
<p>Reminder</p>	<p>Remember we will have PE every Thursday so you will need to come into school in your PE kit.</p> <p>Red Squirrels have their first forest school session next week. Please can they come to school in their forest school clothes with puddle suits and wellies in a bag.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>In Maths this week we have been using a part whole model and partitioning numbers into two parts. We have been using the stem sentence: A part is ... A part is ... The whole is ... to explain how we have partitioned amounts. We have also been writing a number sentence to match our part whole models focusing on addition.</p> 
<p>English</p>	<p>In English we read the story Charlie's Superhero Underpants. This is a quest story. We started the week by writing our own quest stories and created a group text map to accompany the model text. We worked on orally re-telling the story using pictures and props and thought about our favourite parts of the story.</p>
<p>Phonics</p>	<p>This week in Phonics we have been recapping our phase 3 graphemes and starting to look at some phase 5 graphemes: ay, a_e, and other ai alternatives (neigh, great, steak, vein, grey, eight, survey)</p> <p>We have been reading and writing words with these new sounds.</p>

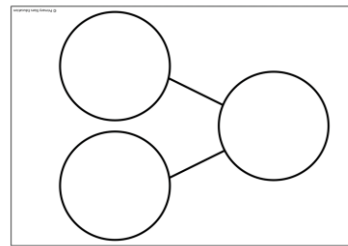
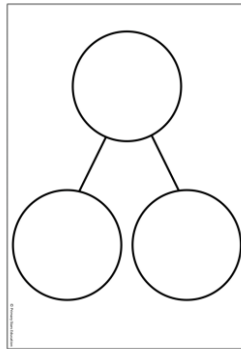
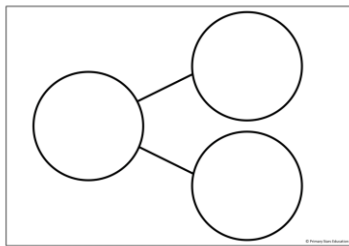
This week's spellings:
