<p>This week in Year Two ...</p>	<p>We had such a wonderful time performing our harvest assembly! We hope you enjoyed the songs.</p> <p>In art, the children created some beautiful paintings inspired by Alma Woodsey Thomas. They were tasked to create a piece inspired by hot or cold places, using their colour mixing to create relevant colours. They recapped learning from Year 1 by mixing primary colours, but also learnt how to create tints and tones by using white or black paint.</p> <p>In PSHE, the children learnt the meaning of 'responsibilities' and that these become more common as we get older. The children discussed a range of different responsibilities they have at home and at school, before ranking them in order of importance.</p>

<p>English</p>	<p>In English this week, the children concluded their fiction unit by writing their own invented quest stories. They then started their new non-fiction unit on information texts. They wrote an information text about their class teacher and then looked at the new vocabulary in our model text.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>This week, the children continued their unit on addition and subtraction. They learnt to add three 1-digit numbers and how to add to the next 10.</p>
<p>Phonics & Spelling</p>	<p>This week we have been learning how to add the suffix -ed or -ing to words containing ai or ay. We also learnt how to spell the 'ee' sound spelt ee, ea or y. This weeks spellings are: waiting, stayed, painting, street, dream, party, key, donkey</p>
