<p>English</p>	<p>In English this week, the children learnt about the key features found in non-chronological reports. They researched, planned and wrote their own information texts about emperor penguins.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>This week, the children continued their unit on addition and subtraction. They learnt how to exchange for the first time, both for addition and subtraction between a two-digit and a one-digit number. They also learnt how to subtract from a multiple of ten.</p>
