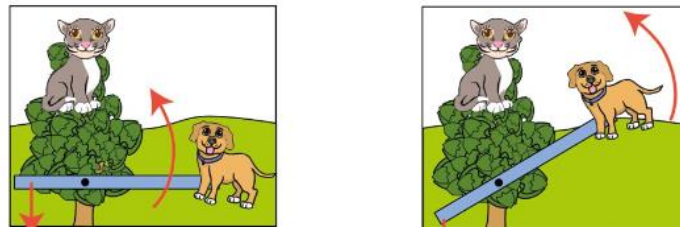
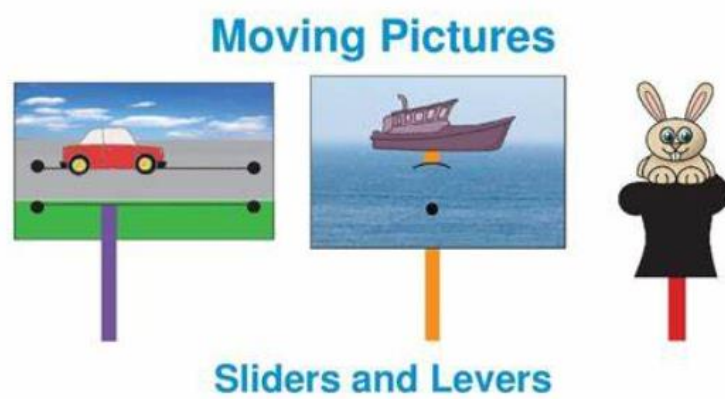

<p><i>This week in Year Two ...</i></p>	<p>In DT, the children worked together to create an informative picture book which tells the story of Grace Darling. They were tasked to design a page each which must have a moving part included on their design. They learnt how to make levers, pivots and sliders. Their finished products are absolutely beautiful and we can't wait to show you them during our reading morning!</p> <p>This week we were lucky to have a visit from a RNLI volunteer. We learnt more about Grace Darling and also about the important work of the RNLI. In addition, we learnt how to keep ourselves safe near water.</p>

<p>English</p>	<p>This week, the children have read and started to learn Gracie the Lighthouse Cat by Ruth Brown. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tt3FDAvmD-g They have acted out the story using vocabulary from the text, hot seated 'Gracie' and written a diary entry as if we were one of the characters. In addition, they have practised using conjunctions to join two sentences (and but so or) e.g. The boy went to the park but his sister stayed at home</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>This week, the children have continued their unit on addition and subtraction. They learnt to add and subtract across a 10, where exchanging was needed. They then completed addition number sentences where they had to identify whether they needed to exchange or not.</p>
<p>Phonics & Spelling</p>	<p>This week we have been reviewing the /i:/ sound spelt igh, i, i_e, ie and y. This weeks spellings are: nineteen, invite, tie, high, sky, try, replying, spying Please encourage your children to learn these at home ready for the Big Spell at the end of the half term.</p>
