<p><i>This week in Year Two ...</i></p>	<p>We have continued to rehearse for our Christmas production this week and have been busy practising speaking and singing clearly and confidently.</p> <p>In computing, the children have been learning how to type using both hands. They have written sentences using the space bar, enter and backspace keys.</p> <p>In R.E, we enjoyed a visit from a local Christian. We had the opportunity to ask them how the church and Christians prepare for Christmas. We then created reverse advent calendars, thinking of 24 kind acts we could do this December to help other people.</p> <p>In PSHE, we continued our unit on Celebrating Difference.
