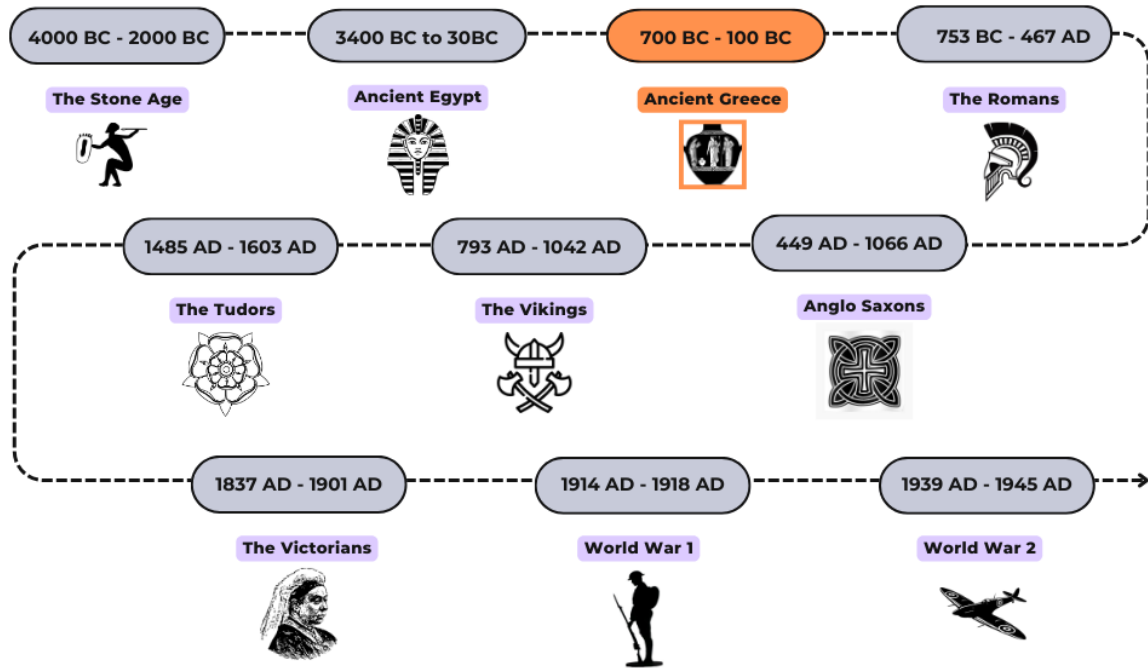

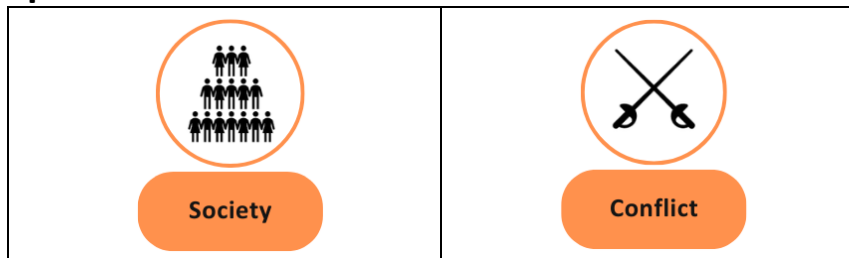

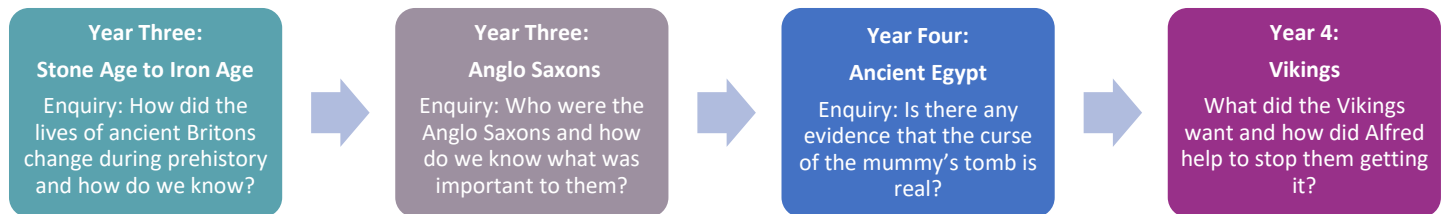

Key Vocabulary

Word	Definition
Primary source	An original document or artefact from a time period or a person who has firsthand knowledge about events.
Secondary source	An article or book that discusses information that was first presented somewhere else.
Archaeologist	A person who studies prehistoric civilisations.
Democracy	Government based on participation of the people, either directly or by chosen representatives.
Myth	A story that's told again and again and serves to explain why something is the way it is.
Legend	A story about mythical beings that gets passed down from one generation to the next.
Tactics	Carefully planned actions for attaining a certain goal.
Hierarchy	A system that organizes or ranks things, often according to power or importance.
