

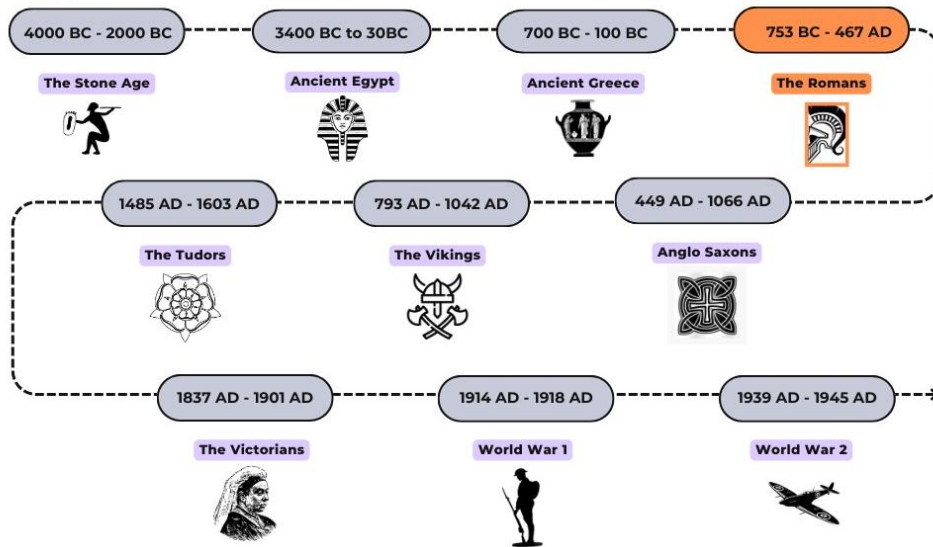

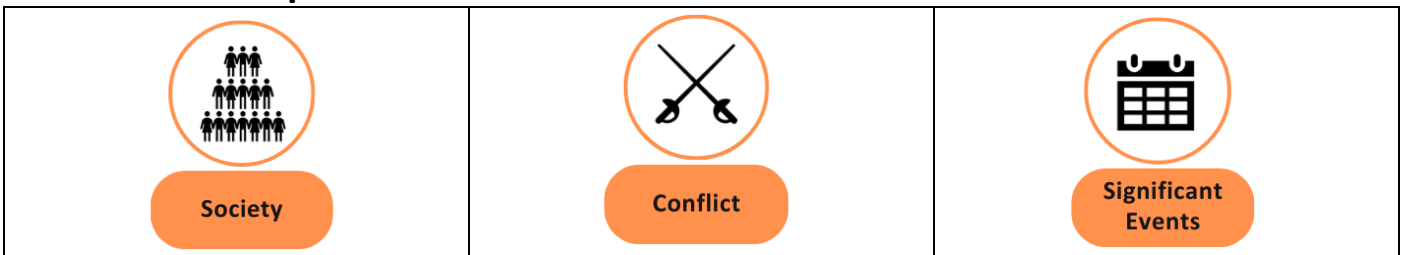

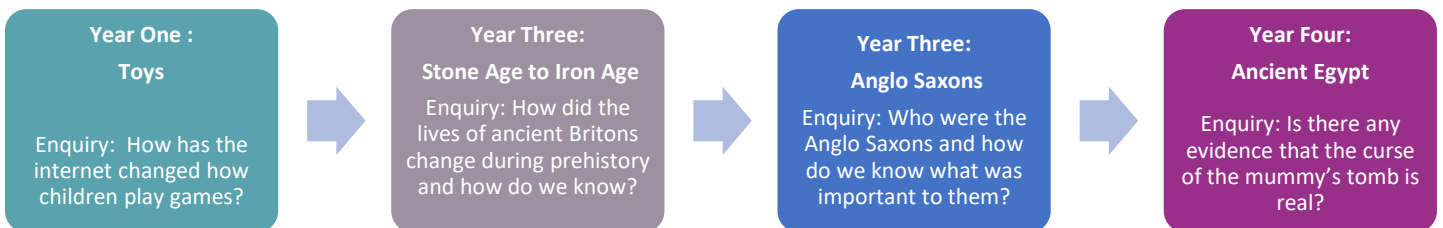

Word	Definition
Army	An organised group of fighters.
Citizen	Someone who has rights in a particular place.
Conquer	To defeat someone or something usually with force, e.g. with an army.
Government	The system of laws, people and officials that define and control the country you live in.
Invasion	The movement of an army into a region as part of a war or conflict.
Leader	The person in charge, who convinces others to follow.
Military	Describes anything related to armed forces such as the army or navy.
Rebel	To fight against authority (those in power).
Repress	To control or limit freedoms.
Retreat	To withdraw soldiers away from danger.
Society	People living together in a community, sharing culture.
Soldier	Someone who is part of an army.
Warrior	Someone experienced in warfare.
