

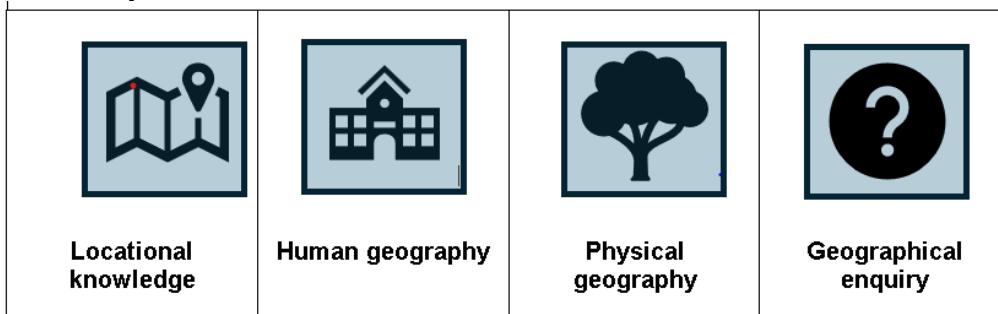

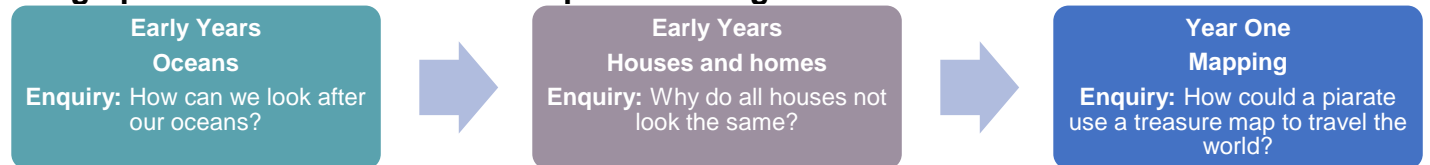

Word	Definition
<b>North pole</b>	The North Pole is the northernmost point on Earth.
<b>South pole</b>	The South Pole is the southernmost point on Earth
<b>Equator</b>	An equator is an imaginary line around the middle of earth. It is halfway between the north pole and the south pole
<b>Cold area</b>	A place where it is cold. Antarctica is the coldest place in the world.
<b>Hot area</b>	A place where it is hot. The Sahara is the hottest desert in the world.
<b>Location</b>	The place where something is.
<b>Feature</b>	Geographic features include things that can be described as locations, sites, areas or regions.
