We then explored using prime colours to mix and make other colours. We also looked at our facial features and what colour our eyes, hair and skin are. We talked about how wonderful it is that we are all so different in what we like to play with, what we like to do and also what we look like. We then used our previous colour mixing learning to explore making an accurate self-portrait.</i></p>
