<b>This week in Year Early Years ...</b>	<p><i>This week, we have been investigating our local environment. We have been looking at photos of human and physical/natural features and discussing where they can be located in our school grounds. We also learned how to gather information from a satellite view of a location.</i></p>
<b>English</b>	<p><i>We have been very busy being detectives...on Monday morning there was a lot of commotion in the hall. We all went to investigate and found porridge oats all over the floor, a big chair and a middle-sized chair and a small chair toppled over on the floor! It was a mystery as to what had happened. We then read a story called Goldilocks and the Three Bears, which sparked ideas about what might have happened in the hall!</i></p>
<b>Maths</b>	<p><i>We have been learning about matching and sorting things this week. Exploring objects around us and how we can match them by their size, colour or pattern. We had a water tray full of dirty socks that we had to find the matching pair with and a box of buttons that needed sorting by size, colour, how many buttonholes.</i></p>
<b>Phonics</b>	<p><i>Sounds we have learned: s, a, t, p</i> <i>This week we have been learning how to orally blend simple words such as s-a-t, p-a-t</i></p>
