Early Years

This week in Year Early Years ...	<p>This week, we have learned the word 'town' and have discussed the town that we live in, Saffron Walden. We looked at a World map together and discussed where our town is, in the 'country' of England. Then we shared special places to us, some of them were close by and some were further afield in different countries.</p>
English	<p>We have continued our learning using our key text 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Our focus has been on the characters, and we have been considering 'Who' they are. We had a guessing game where we had to describe characters and guess 'Who' our friends were describing.</p>
Maths	<p>This week we have been learning about 'subitising', where we say what we see. We do not need to count and just say how many of something we see. Our focus has been 1, 2 and 3. We had to sort picture cards where we subitised how many dots we could see.</p>
Phonics	<p>Sounds we have learned: i, n, m, d This week we have been learning how to orally blend simple words such as p-i-n, s-a-t. We have been using magnetic whiteboards to orally segment and blend to spell and read words.</p>
Homework	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Please continue to read with your child and use the Bug Club log in to access wordless books.• Play some dice games, can your child recognise (subitise) the dots on the dice? Look through books can your child 'subitise' how many of something on the page (recognise the amount without counting 1-3, challenge 4-5).
