This week in Year Early Years ...	<p>This week, we have been exploring our understanding of the past. We looked at photos of Ms Coote and Miss Beckett and had to consider the order we may put them in. We then discussed our baby, toddler and present photos. It was lovely to look at our friends photos and talk about how we have changed over time.</p>
English	<p>We have continued our learning using our key text 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Our focus has been on the verbs this week. We have been using our colourful semantics to explore orally constructing sentences using the 'Who' and 'What doing' parts of a sentence. This has including describing pictures and playing charades.</p>
Maths	<p>This week we have been teaching the three bears how to count carefully. They kept getting muddled when counting objects. We taught them that the last number is the total amount, and that touching or moving each object helps to track counting.</p>
Phonics	<p>Sounds we have learned: g, a, c, k This week we have continued our learning on orally segmenting and blending words. We have also learned our first 'tricky word', that is a word we cannot sound out and have to remember how to read it. Our Tricky word this week was: 'to'</p>
