This week in Year Early Years ...	<p>This week, we have been exploring ourselves. We have been learning about different parts of our bodies, naming parts of our bodies and what we use them for. We also looked at our five senses and how these are used and why we have them.</p>
English	<p>We have continued our learning using our key text 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. Our focus has been innovating our stories this week. We have been wonderful authors that have explored changing the Three Bears to Three Bunnies and thinking about something else that Goldilocks ate when she visited their cottage.</p>
Maths	<p>This week we have been continuing our learning around subitising. Using our subitising skills to quickly recall an amount by saying what we see. We have been making sets of 2 and 3, e.g. 1 and another 1 makes 2.</p>
Phonics	<p>Sounds we have learned: ck, e, u, r This week we have continued our learning on orally segmenting and blending words. This week we learned about 'digraphs', two letters (graphemes) that make one sound: 'ck'. Our Tricky word this week: the, no, go</p>
