<b>This week in Year One...</b>	<p>This week in Year 1, we have been continuing with our unit in art, looking at sculpture. We have studied the artist Andy Goldsworthy and created our own sculptures using man made materials. We are now looking forward to planning and making our own sculptures using natural materials.</p> <p>Red Squirrels thoroughly enjoyed their last session at forest school. Skylarks have finished their computing unit, looking at what is 'personal information' and who we should share it with. We also talked about the idea of ownership and copyright, creating our own images using SketchesSchool and uploading them to Seesaw.</p>
<b>Maths</b>	<p>In Maths this week, we have been learning our number bonds to 10. We have also been telling stories with our numbers using first, then and now story boards. We then wrote an addition number sentence to match the story.</p>
