Year One – Week Commencing 25th November 2025

This week in Year One...	<p>We really enjoyed our topic launch with our fantastic toy museum run by our Year 1 families. The children got to explore the toys and ask lots of interesting questions.</p> <p>We have continued our art unit on printing, looking at different prints and designing our own Christmas card. We are very excited to start making these in the next few weeks. Our clay tiles have been fired in the kiln and are ready for glazing.</p>
Maths	<p>In maths, we have now started to look at numbers between 11 and 19 and understand their value. We learned how to represent these numbers using concrete resources (base 10) and how to write these in numerals. We also began to learn about the value of each part of a two-digit number, e.g. in 12, the '1' is worth one 10.</p>
English	<p>In English, this week we have been innovating the story of Knuffle Bunny. We changed Knuffle Bunny to a toy car and gave it name. We also changed the location in which Knuffle Bunny goes missing. We then wrote our new stories with a focus on capital letters, full stops, and finger spaces.</p>
Phonics	<p>In Phonics this week we have been revisiting all our phase 5 phonemes that we learnt last half term. We have read different words and sentences containing these sounds and then applied this knowledge to our writing.</p>
This week's spellings:	<p>You will find this week's spellings have been stuck in your child's reading diary. Please help your child learn their spellings ready for their first Big Spell at the end of this term.</p>
Homework	<p>Read everyday and record in your reading record.</p> <p>Learn your spellings.</p> <p>You may also like to create flashcards 0-20. The children can write these themselves! Can you order the numbers 0-20?</p>
