Year One – Week Commencing 1st December 2025

This week in Year One...	<p>In Year 1 we have enjoyed our science lesson where we have been thinking about why day becomes night and night becomes day and how day light length varies throughout the year.</p> <p>In PSHE we have been continuing our topic “Celebrating difference”. We have been discussing what bullying means and who we could talk to if we were worried.</p>
Maths	<p>In maths, we continued our new learning of place value, numbers up to 20. The children have enjoyed focusing on 1 more and 1 less. We have also used a number line and compared numbers to 20.</p>
English	<p>In English, we started to learn our new model text: Jingle Bear. It is a non-fiction report with facts all about a favourite toy. We started to learn some new vocabulary to support our writing. We have also been learning about the features of a non-fiction report ready to write our own non-fiction report about our toy.</p>
Phonics	<p>In Phonics this week we have been revisiting all our phase 5 phonemes that we learnt so far as well as focusing on this week’s alternative spelling of or : aw, au, al our in words such as yawn, author, talk and your. We have read different words and sentences containing these sounds and then applied this knowledge to our writing.</p>
This week’s spellings:	<p>You will find this week’s spellings have been stuck in your child’s reading diary. Please help your child learn their spellings ready for their BIG SPELL in the final week of term.</p>
Homework:	<p>Read everyday and record in your reading record.</p> <p>Learn your spellings.</p> <p>To continue our learning in Science you could talk about what do you notice about outside, what changes can you see? Think about some of your usual activities and whether it is light or dark outside when you do them.</p>
