



Weekly Learning Letter

Year One – Week Commencing 6.1.26

This week in Year One...	<p>We have had an exciting start to the term with the launch of our new topic 'Once Upon a Time' and a trip to the theatre to see Rapunzel.</p> <p>In Skylarks this week we have started our new computing unit on coding. The children got to code a robot to make it move forward and backwards and turn. The children got to programme their own instructions to move the robot around a course.</p> <p>In Red Squirrels this week we have started our new RE unit on Judaism. In the first session we looked at what Jewish people remember about Shabbat and retold the Jewish story of creation.</p>
English	<p>In English, we have been learning about The Three Little Pigs. We started the topic off with a visit from Mrs Trotter and the wolf and had to decide which of the characters was telling the truth about what really happened to the houses and the pigs. We have learnt new vocabulary and our model text for the three little pigs and acted out parts of the story.</p>
Maths	<p>In Maths, we have been learning to combine and partition tens and ones to make numbers 11-19. We have used tens frames, part whole models and pictorial representations.</p>
Phonics	<p>In Phonics this week we have been learning the phase 5 sounds: ou, oy and A (ar sound).</p> <p>We have also recapped a lot of the sounds we learnt last term. We have read different words and sentences containing these new sounds and then applied this knowledge to our writing.</p>
This week's spellings:	<p>This week's spellings have been stuck into your child's reading diary. Please help your child to learn these words at home each week so they are ready for the Big Spell at the end of the half term.</p>
Homework:	<p>Read everyday and record in your reading record.</p> <p>Learn your spellings.</p>

To continue your child's learning you could have a listen to the story of the three little pigs. With your grown ups you can re-tell the story of the three little pigs. You could act out the different characters and add in some dialogue to explain how you might be feeling at different parts of the story.
