



Weekly Learning Letter

Year One – Week Commencing 19.1.26

This week in Year One...	<p>This week in Science we have been looking at the properties of different materials and comparing and grouping materials based on the properties they have.</p> <p>We have also continued with our art learning and have enjoyed experimenting with card, crepe paper, sugar paper and tissue paper to explore collage inspired by Henri Matisse. We have experimented using different skills such as layering.</p>
English	<p>In English, we have continued our learning about The Three Little Pigs. We have been learning about similes and creating our own writing with similes to describe different animals. We have also started to innovate the text to create our own version of the story. We have focused on using adjectives to describe our new houses.</p>
Maths	<p>In maths, we have focused on addition and subtraction within 20. We have focussed on addition by counting on using number lines and number beads and in subtraction looked at partitioning tens and ones to subtract.</p>
Phonics	<p>In Phonics this week we have been learning about the suffix 'ing' and how it can be added to a root word: jump – jumping. We also read words with the sound c, ck and k and spent some time learning to spell a range of tricky words.</p> <p>We have also recapped a lot of the sounds we learnt last term. We have read different words and sentences containing these new sounds and then applied this knowledge to our writing.</p>
This week's spellings:	<p>This week's spellings have been stuck into your child's reading diary. Please help your child to learn these words at home each week so they are ready for the Big Spell at the end of the half term.</p>
Homework	<p>Read everyday and record in your reading record.</p> <p>Learn your spellings.</p> <p>To continue your child's learning you could practise subtraction using https://www.topmarks.co.uk/subtraction/subtraction-to-10</p>
