



# Weekly Learning Letter

Year One – Week Commencing 26.1.26

<p><b>This week in Year One...</b></p>	<p>This week in Red Squirrels we have started our new computing unit on coding. The children got to programme a robot using code to make it move forward, backwards and turn and then move the robot around a course.</p> <p>In Skylarks we have started our new RE unit on Judaism. In the first session we looked at what Jewish people remember about Shabbat and retold the Jewish story of creation.</p> <p>In Art we have been planning our collages inspired by Matisse. We have been thinking about shape, colour and texture.</p>
<p><b>English</b></p>	<p>In English, we have been writing our own version of the three little pigs. The children changed the characters in the story and picked a new 'baddie'. The children created their own story mountain to plan their ideas and orally rehearsed their stories. The children then wrote up their stories with a focus on capital letter, full stops, adjectives and using the five part story plan.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p>In maths, we have been completing fact families for numbers within 20. <b>E.g <math>12 + 4 = 16</math>, <math>4 + 12 = 16</math>, <math>16 - 12 = 4</math> and <math>16 - 4 = 12</math>.</b> We have also been comparing numbers within 20 and working out missing number problems.</p>
<p><b>Phonics</b></p>	<p>In phonics this week we spelt words ending in nk and ve.          We have learnt to read: please, school          We have learnt to spell: once, our, two</p>
<p><b>This week's spellings:</b></p>	<p>This week's spellings have been stuck into your child's reading diary. Please help your child to learn these words at home each week so they are ready for the Big Spell at the end of the half term.</p>
<p><b>Homework</b></p>	<p>Read every day and record in your reading record.</p> <p>Learn your spellings.</p> <p>To continue your child's learning you could work on your Phase 5 phonics sounds.
