Foundation Subjects

In science, the children concluded their unit on materials. The children designed and completed an experiment which tested which material would be the best to make a raincoat out of. They focused on their method, ensuring only one variable was changed.

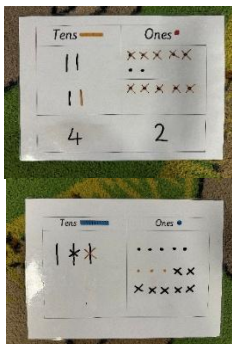
In computing, the children completed their unit on information technology. The children learnt what information technology is and how it is used in school and the wider world. They learnt that it could speed up jobs and be a useful tool. They discussed how to use information technology safely and learnt about how a digital 5-a-day can help them to develop a healthier relationship with this type of technology.

English



This week, the children concluded their non-fiction unit on diaries. The children wrote and published a diary entry from the perspective of Billy when he goes on an adventure with the swan at nighttime. Their published pieces were collated into class books.

Maths



This week, the children concluded their unit on addition and subtraction. They recapped how to add and subtract two 2-digit numbers with and without exchanging, and learnt how to subtract from a ten.
