<p>This week in Year One...</p>	<p>Year 1 have had a fantastic week and thoroughly enjoyed the Easter Egg Hunt in the nature garden and taking part in the Easter hat parade around the school.</p> <p>The children have enjoyed our Art topic on drawing and learnt to use lines, show texture, patterns and tone. We looked at the work of the artist Paul Klee. In their final piece, the children used these skills to draw an imaginary beast.</p>

<p>Maths</p>	<p>In Maths this week we have been consolidating our learning of length and height., mass and capacity, and numbers to 50.</p>
<p>Phonics</p>	<p>In Phonics this week we have been revisiting our learning and looking at plurals. This week we will be sending home a letter with any phonemes and tricky words that you can practise with your child</p>
