<p>This week in Year One...</p>	<p>Red Squirrels had a great trip to the Aerozone at Stansted Airport where the children got to learn about the history of aeroplanes, role play different airport related jobs and stand at the viewing platform watching planes takes off and land. Skylarks look forward to their visit next week.</p> <p>In art, this week we have been learning about the artist Kandinsky. We thought about colour and types of brush stroke and how this changes depending on the mood created by the music. In computer we have been learning how to create digital art.</p>
<p>English</p>	<p>In English, this week we have been writing our own Mrs Armitage stories using our five part story plan. We have focused on capital letters, full stops, adjectives and conjunctions. We also tried hard to form all of our letters correctly.</p>
<p>Maths</p>	<p>In maths this week, we continued learning about fractions. The children have been recognising half a quantity and learning about quarters</p>
<p>Phonics</p>	<p>In Phonics this week we have been revisiting split digraphs, ie (fried and chief) and au/aw, as well as re-capping all of our phase 5 phonemes. We have read different words and sentences containing these new sounds and then applied this knowledge to our writing. We have also been learning a range of tricky words. Remember that on top of the spellings we send home each week you will also find lists of words for the children to read and write in their reading diaries.</p>
