Foundation Subjects



The children have completed their end of year assessments this week. It was such a joy to see just how much they have learnt this year – it was certainly reflected in their fantastic results.

Arctic Wolves enjoyed their second forest school session this week! The children enjoyed the mud slide, rope swing and even got to use a saw to create their own wooden necklaces.

In art, the children started their new unit on sculpture. The children learnt about surrealism and their new inspirational icon, Salvador Dali. They researched his art, created observational drawings of mini beasts and created a class flipbook of different mini beasts. They then designed their own surrealist mini beasts, ready to sculpt next week.

Maths



This week, the children started their new unit on height. They learnt how to measure in centimetres and metres, and when it is appropriate to measure in these units. They then compared various lengths and heights by using inequality symbols.

Phonics & Spelling



This week, we have been learning how spell words that have apostrophes for contractions (e.g. you've and for possession e.g. Finley's). They also revisited compound words.

This weeks spellings are: **benches, knives, you've, you're, we're, we've, they're they've**

If your child receives alternative spellings, these have been stuck in their reading diary.

Homework

2. Learn this week's spellings ready for the Big Spell at the end of the half term. These have been stuck in your child's reading diary.
3. Practise your 2, 5 and 10 times tables on Times Table Rock Stars or Hit the Button.
