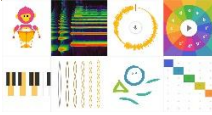


Weekly Learning Letter

Foundation Subjects



The children were very excited to receive a letter from Buckingham Palace this week! The King was very complimentary of their beautiful quilt patch designs.

Arctic Wolves enjoyed their final forest school session this week! The children enjoyed cooking their crumpets over the fire.

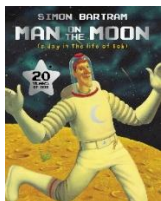
In art, the children concluded their unit on sculpture. The children created surrealist Modroc sculptures of their mini beast designs. Once dry, they painted them. Finally, they evaluated their creations.

In computing, the children continued their music unit. They used Chrome Music Labs to explore making different rhythms with a range of instruments.

In PSHE, the children started their new unit Changing Me. They thought about how animals and plants change, and that these changes are beyond our control. They also thought about an older person in their lives that they love and respect.

In science, the children continued their unit on living things and their habitats. The children learnt what microhabitats are, what the conditions are like in them and the animals that live there.

English



The children continued their narrative unit centred around *The Man on the Moon: A Day in the Life of Bob* by Simon Bartram. The children explored their six new pieces of vocabulary from their model text: extravagant, astronaut, contains, crater, jetting and wits. They then worked in small groups to create story scrolls to help them begin to learn their model text.

Maths



This week, the children concluded their unit on height. The children ordered a range of lengths and heights, and then applied their knowledge of measurement to solve word problems.
