



Weekly Learning Letter

Year One – Week Commencing 29.6.26

This week in Year One...	<i>In Science, the children studied our class tree and discussed how it has changed across the 4 sessions. They then made a mini-book using Book Creator to represent their learning from over the year on seasons. In Science we have also started to look at flowering plants and learn the names for the different parts.</i> <i>In PSHE, we continued our Changing Me unit. We had a lot of fun looking at photos of each other when we were babies! We discussed how our bodies have changed since we were babies and that everyone grows at a different rate. In our Changing Me unit, we also identified parts of the body and realised that this differs between each sex. We ensured that children were taught and used the correct, scientific terminology for body parts.</i>
English	<i>In English, we finished writing our pirate stories and then started our next unit on poetry. We have been learning the Owl and the Pussy Cat, demonstrating our understanding of the text and predicating what would happen next.</i>
Maths	<i>In maths, we continued our unit on money. We looked at the value of different coins and notes. We have also compared coins and used the inequality symbols to show our understanding.</i>
Phonics	<i>In Phonics this week we have been revisiting all our Phase 5 phonemes. We have read different words and sentences containing these new sounds and then applied this knowledge to our writing. We have also been learning a range of tricky words. Remember that on top of the spellings we send home each week you will also find lists of words for the children to read and write in their reading diaries.</i>
Homework	<i>Read every day and record in your reading record.</i> <i>To continue your learning you could practise reading and spelling the high frequency words that are in the reading record.</i>
