Year One – Week Commencing 6.7.26

<i>This week in Year One...</i>	We have enjoyed taking part in Creative Arts Week. Our theme has been “Good to be me”. We have been inspired by different artists and created a collaborative piece of art work and an individual piece of art. We have thoroughly enjoyed dissecting fruit in science. The children have looked at the different seeds and how many can be found in each fruit. We then planted some seeds and we are looking forward to see what happens. In Science we also enjoyed identifying and naming common wild and garden plants. We looked for them around the school grounds and wildlife garden.
<i>English</i>	<i>In English, we have selected imperative verbs and applied them to a sentence to give an instruction. We also look at time words used in instructions and then wrote our own set of instructions linked to finding treasure.</i>
<i>Mathematics</i>	<i>In Mathematics, we continued our unit on time. We looked at the months of the year and began to read time to the hour and the half hour.</i>
<i>Phonics</i>	<i>In Phonics this week we have been revisiting all our Phase 5 phonemes. We have read different words and sentences containing these new sounds and then applied this knowledge to our writing. We have also been learning a range of tricky words. Remember that there are lists of words for the children to read and write in their reading diaries.</i>
<i>This week's spellings:</i>	<i>This week's spellings have been stuck into your child's reading diary. Please help your child to learn these words at home each week.</i>
<i>Homework</i>	Read every day and record in your reading record. <i>To continue your learning you could practise</i> counting in 2s, 5s and 10s by splatting the numbers on the 100 grid: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/paint-the-squares
