Event Information

We are hosting a sponsored ride to raise money for the school and would love it if you and your family could attend to take part. We hope to see as many students and families as possible over the day to make this a great summer event!

HOW DOES IT WORK

We are setting up a course going around our school; see the map provided. You can raise money by completing laps of the course and getting family and friends to sponsor you per lap or a fixed amount to take part.

The course will be open between 10am - 3pm as below -

- 10am - 11am : priority slot for younger and inexperienced riders
- 11am - 2pm : anyone welcome!
- 2pm: registration closed.
- 3pm: course closed.

When you arrive, please register at the main stand, and you will be given a certificate. For every lap you complete, you will get a stamp on your certificate. Once you have finished, these will be counted, and the total will be recorded. You can then take this home to show the people who have sponsored you to collect the money. Money can be brought into school after the event and given to your teachers along with the sponsor form or your parents can pay this via school money.

PRIZES

Each child who competes will receive a certificate and a participation prize.

There will also be prizes available for most laps (prize per year group) and most sponsorship money raised (whole school). Class merits and House points are also available for competing.

IF YOU CAN'T MAKE IT ON THE DAY

If you are unable to attend on the day, you can go for a ride with your family and record the distance. Every 400m = 1 lap of the school. Prizes for the most laps of the school can only be awarded to students who ride the course, but the prize for the most sponsorship money raised is still available.



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WHAT YOU CAN RIDE

All wheels are welcome! You can ride bikes, bikes with stabilisers, scooters, balance bikes, trikes, and wheelchairs. **Please remember your helmet!**

FACILITIES

- Refreshments will be available for purchase.
- The main school reception toilet will be accessible.
- Bike/scooter maintenance area for basic repairs and adjustments, including people on hand to help out at various times.
- First aid – we will have some trained first aiders on site, but parents remain responsible for their children.

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS & DISCLAIMER

PARENTS - PLEASE READ

- There will be event organisers and parent volunteers on hand, but parents and guardians are primarily responsible for their children on the day and therefore are taking part at their own risk.
- This is a parent-run event, not organised by teachers, therefore parents should remain on site to supervise their children at all times
- Children must wear helmets at all times while on the course. We also recommend elbow and knee pads, although these are not compulsory to take part.
- Older siblings beyond our school years are not allowed to take part for safety reasons.
- Please remember water bottles and sun cream if the sun is out!
- We will make a weather call on Friday based on the forecast, and if it looks wet, the event will be postponed for safety reasons.
