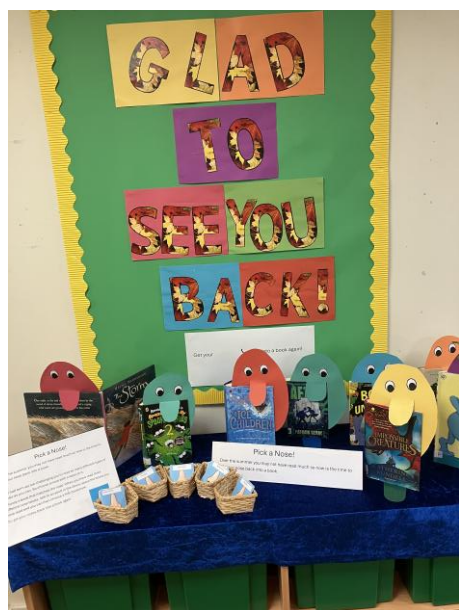


Library Newsletter September 2026
